

## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE BYLAW OF SKATE CANADA

This document outlines all submitted proposals, amendments and repeals to the bylaws of Skate Canada for consideration at the 2025 Annual General Meeting in accordance with Article 12 of the bylaws.

Please note that as per Article 12, the following groups had until 90 days prior to the Annual General Meeting (February 23, 2025) to file with the Chief Executive Officer notice of any proposals, amendments and repeals to the bylaws of Skate Canada:

- Skate Canada Board of Directors
- Skate Canada Sections
- Skate Canada clubs or skating schools in good standing
- Certified professional coaches in good standing

Amendments have been presented as follows:

  - the other bylaws that will be affected by this amendment (housekeeping)
- Effective date of the amendment
- Wording added to a bylaw is <u>underlined</u>

## Recommended Bylaw Amendment 1 of 1

## **Recommended change:**

That section 5.9 of the Bylaw is deleted and the remaining sections renumbered accordingly.

## **Rationale:**

The purpose of this amendment is to eliminate the reference to partial terms served by Elected Directors. Section 5.9 provides inequity between Elected and Additional Directors and is no longer required as maximum term limits are established for all Directors.
